Dear Mrs. Sharp:

In reply to your letter of June 1, regarding John Gandy. We have records on a Mr. John E. Gandy. His discharge certificate is not in our files, but we have a letter dated May 13, 1925 from Edmund Gandy, R.#1 Box 89, Marceline, Missouri asking for his Father's discharge.

The application for admission shows that Mr. Gandy was enrolled in the service at Bird's Point, Missouri, August 24, 1861 and was discharged January 4, 1864 at Vicksburg, M ss. He subsequently reenlisted on that date and was discharged July 22, 1865 at Louisville, Kentucky.

Mr. Gandy was a Private in Co. K. Regiment 41, Illinois Infantry during his first period of service and was a Private in Co. K. Regiment 53, Illinois Infantry during his last period of service. He received a pension of \$12.00 per month under certificate number 663054.

Our records also indicate that he was under care for an old gun shot wound on his left foot when he was admitted here.

If we can be of further help, please let us know.
